- Performs routine transport of work-in-process materials between workstations.
- Performs and documents in-process measurements.
- Fulfills all required documentation completely and accurately per cGMP requirements.
- Performs routine daily maintenance and cleaning as required.
- Verifies that finished products are packaged and labelled properly.
- Ensures appropriate corrective and containment actions are taken against defects or process discrepancies.
- Rotate workstations as needed and maintain all skills for each procedure per the applicable training matrix.
- Maintains a clean and orderly work environment.
